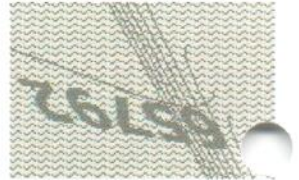

Dear Mayor Flores:

Welcome to the Peace in Our Cities Campaign! Peace in Our Cities seeks to create concrete, participatory, and evidence-based platforms for progress towards achieving Sustainable Development Goal 16, with an initial focus on SDG16.1 to significantly reduce all forms of violence and related death rates everywhere. To launch the campaign, we are building a coalition of early adopters – including cities, sub-national authorities and targeted thematic partners – inviting them to sign the Peace in Our Cities SDG16 Action Pledge this September and join a 12-month Action Committee.

We are thrilled and honored that you have joined as an early adopter to lead this Campaign. To make the onboarding of this campaign as simple as possible, this Welcome Letter outlines the primary next action steps.

1. Focal Point Contact Information: Please confirm with us who will serve as the primary focal point for communications over the course of the next 12 months.

2. Quote of Endorsement: Please provide us with a “quote of endorsement” as soon as possible, and no later than 19th September, to share in our global press release and launch materials. Below is an example. Please make this unique to your city as appropriate. We are happy to provide additional ideas for language should you be interested.

The City of Escobedo is proud to launch the Peace in Our Cities Campaign with a global coalition of Mayors and partners. Globally, 82% of deadly violence occurs outside of conflict zones, with much of this violence concentrated in urban settings. I am signing the Peace in Our Cities SDG16 Action Pledge to lead global momentum towards reducing levels of violence, and to help shape a city-to-city collaboration framework to drive global best practice in support of Sustainable Development Goal 16.1 – to significantly reduce all forms of violence.

3. Signing the Peace in Our Cities SDG16 Action Pledge: We ask that all campaign partners sign a Peace in Our Cities SDG16 Action Pledge and take a picture or video during the signing. We will provide this pledge by 13th September at the latest.

4. September Launch Activities: We invite all campaign partners to announce the

- a. Join us in New York City, USA, for two launch events, in which we are inviting you to give 5 minute remarks:
 - i. Saturday, 21st September: Peace Day Celebration and +Peace Coalition Launch (invite-only event)
 - ii. Tuesday, 24th September: Evening Reception Celebrating Accelerator Actions on the SDGs (link [here](#))
- b. Sign the Pledge on International Day of Peace and share you're doing so with local and/or national stakeholders.
- c. Share global press release with local and national press contacts.

Following the launch of Peace in Our Cities, we will pursue a 12-month interactive exchange of knowledge, idea generation and peer support. The first steps of the campaign are detailed below, with additional opportunities to follow as more partners are added to our coalition. We will send additional details on all Action Committee activities shortly after the September launch.

- A 2-day Action Committee Political Retreat, February 2020
- Virtual Action Committee Calls (bi-monthly):
- Distribution of a final Peace in Our Cities Action Committee Report, August 2020
